TITLE:

Job Order Authorization: Avenue 6E Multiuse Pathway

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a job order with CEMEX Construction Materials South LLC, in an amount not to exceed \$350,275.93, for capital improvements to Avenue 6E through the City's Job Order Contracting program. (Engineering) (Jeffrey A. Kramer)

REPORT:

This job order to CEMEX Construction Materials South LLC (Contractor) per the following City Job Order Master Contract (JOC Contract): Contract #2019-20000036, Transportation Facilities, Pathways and Pavement, awarded December 5, 2018 authorizes the construction of a walking pathway to the new elementary school.

Pursuant to the JOC Contract, the City issues a separate job order for each project assignment. The JOC Contract sets forth the general terms and conditions governing all job orders issued under the contract, with each job order providing the individual project's scope of work and any additional terms and conditions specific to the project.

Under this proposed job order, the Contractor will install a new 10-foot wide asphaltic pavement multiuse pathway on the east side of Avenue 6E from 41st Street to 46th Street. Additional improvements include enhanced crosswalk markings at Avenue 6E and 44th Place for the designated school crossing, and advanced school zone warning signs with solar-powered flashing lights.

The job order requires the Contractor to complete the Project within 60 days after the notice to proceed is issued.

By approving this motion, the City Council authorizes a job order for the referenced project pursuant to the approved JOC Contract.
