TITLE:
Agreement Amendment: Intergovernmental Agreement/Joint Partnership Agreement with the State of Arizona

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:
Amend the language of the Intergovernmental Agreement/Joint Partnership Agreement (IGA/JPA) between the State of Arizona and City of Yuma as previously adopted by Resolution R2016-014. (Engineering/Admin) (Jeff Kramer)

REPORT:
In 2016, the City of Yuma, Arizona (City) executed Resolution R2016-014 to enter into an IGA/JPA with the State of Arizona (State).

This IGA/JPA defines the terms under which the State will design, advertise, and administer the construction of a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (Project) on 8th Street, 200 feet west of the intersection with 21st Avenue. The agreement is required to utilize Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Federal-aid funds that were awarded to the City for the Project.

The original IGA/JPA denotes that the State will provide \$277,349.00 of federal-aid funds for the scoping, design and construction of the project. Bids for the project came in higher than the State's estimate used in the original IGA/JPA. However, City staff were able to procure additional federal-aid funds through the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO). Amendment No. One defines the adjusted project costs and makes several other minor adjustments to the terms of the IGA/JPA that were deemed to be necessary by the State.

The cost of the project is now estimated to be \$319,640.00. The State will utilize \$318,747.00 in federal-aid funds and the City will contribute a local match of \$893.00 for this project.
