

## RESOLUTION NO. R2019-011

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA, PROVIDING FOR A CALL OF ELECTION FOR THE 2019 PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS, DESIGNATING THE ELECTION DATES AND PURPOSE, DESIGNATING THE DEADLINE AND LOCATION FOR CANDIDATES TO FILE NOMINATION PETITIONS, AND DESIGNATING THE DEADLINE FOR VOTER REGISTRATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma primary and general elections for 2019 are required to be held on certain dates pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 16-204, which are August 27, 2019 and November 5, 2019, respectively; and,

WHEREAS, City of Yuma elections are required to fill the offices of three City Council seats and a Municipal Judge, pursuant to the Yuma City Charter.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Yuma, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1: August 27, 2019 shall be the designated date for holding the Primary Election in the City of Yuma, Arizona, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the offices of three City Councilmembers and a Municipal Judge. Pursuant to the Yuma City Charter Article IV, Section 5, any candidate receiving a number of votes constituting a majority of all the ballots cast at the Primary Election shall be declared elected to the office for which the candidate is running effective as of the date of the General Election, provided that if more candidates receive the number of votes constituting a majority of all the ballots cast than there are offices to be filled, then those candidates, equal in number of the offices to be filled receiving the highest number of votes shall be declared to be elected as of the date of the General Election.

SECTION 2: November 5, 2019 is the date for holding the General Election in the City of Yuma, Arizona, for the purpose of electing three City Councilmembers and a Municipal Judge, if they have not been declared elected at the Primary Election.

SECTION 3: Nomination packets were made available to candidates seeking municipal office on the City's website and from the City Clerk's Office, located at Yuma City Hall, One City Plaza, beginning Monday, March 11, 2019. The first day to file nomination papers and other associated forms is Monday, April 29, 2019 and the last day to file is 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 29, 2019. Candidate nomination papers are required to be filed at the City Clerk's Office in order for a candidate's name to appear on the Primary Election ballot.

SECTION 4: Yuma County registration and voting lists will be used for the Primary and General Elections. In order to be qualified to vote in the Primary Election, voters must be registered by July 29, 2019. To be qualified to vote in the General Election, voters must be registered by October 7, 2019.
