**TITLE:**

Grant Award: Arizona Companion Animal Spay and Neuter Committee

**SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the City Administrator to execute the necessary paperwork with Arizona Companion Animal Spay and Neuter Committee (ACASNC) to disperse awarded grant funds to support community spay and neuter surgeries. (Police/Admin) (Susan Smith)

**REPORT:**

Yuma Police Department's (YPD) Animal Control Services unit (Animal Control) is tasked with decreasing the number of stray animals in the community. The ACASNC has awarded \$20,000 in grant funding to Animal Control to spay or neuter domesticated and feral animals. As indicated in the attached award letter, the grant funds will be tendered to the City of Yuma from PETsSMART Charities, which were made available from the support and sales of the ACASNC Arizona automobile License Plates.

The funds will allow Animal Control to direct \$20,000.00 to the Humane Society of Yuma (HSOY) to increase spay and neuter efforts in the community. Animal Control will issue vouchers to HSOY when it renders spay or neuter services. Animal Control will use the grant funds to pay the authorized fees.

All funds must be expended by August 15, 2021, and any unspent funds must be returned with a final follow-up report.

By adopting this Motion, the Mayor and City Council authorize the City Administrator to direct YPD and City Staff to complete and sign the necessary paperwork to obtain grant funding from ACASNC.

In line with City Council's designated Strategic Outcome, this action shows the City is acting in a responsible manner by accepting and dispersing the spay and neuter grant to assist with decreasing the number of stray or unwanted animals in the City of Yuma.
