Agreement Amendment: Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Conservation Program Arizona					

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to ratify the First Supplement to the Trust and Indenture and Joint Payment Agreement for the Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Conservation Program Agreement which was originally approved by motion, and to execute a Second Supplement to the same Agreement. (Utilities/Administration) (Jay Simonton)

REPORT:

In March 2005, the City Council authorized the City of Yuma to participate in the Lower Colorado River Multi-Species Conservation Program (MSCP) by way of resolution creating a Trust Indenture and Joint Payment Agreement (Trust). The MSCP allows federal, state, local and private agencies to continue to conduct legal activities on the lower Colorado River by providing protection from potential violation of the Endangered Species Act.

The MSCP requires each participating agency to authorize changes to the original agreement. On March 20, 2013, the City Council approved the First Supplement to the Trust by motion in order to create a new Remedial Measures Fund and to authorize and direct a portion of the quarterly transfers from the existing Reclamation Disbursement Fund to the new Remedial Measures Fund. With this resolution, the City desires to ratify the motion as part of the MSCP by resolution.

Additionally, a Second Supplement to the Trust is now required as a result of the United States' Western Area Power Administration's (WAPA) reallocation of a portion of the Hoover power to certain Indian Tribes. As a result of the reallocation, those Tribes will contribute a proportionate share of the related costs. The Second Supplement will authorize an adjustment in the Hoover power portion of the MSCP costs as a result of the Indian Tribe contributions.

This adjustment will only have a financial impact on those Arizona MSCP Parties that receive Hoover power. This includes the City of Yuma who pays monthly sums to WAPA for capacity and energy charges, and who will be impacted by this regulation. This Second Supplement will lower the amount the City pays by a nominal amount.
