Grant Award: Arizona Department of Homeland Security

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute the subrecipient agreement for the grant award issued by the Arizona Department of Homeland Security. (Police/Patrol) (Susan Smith)

REPORT:

The Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) has awarded the Yuma Police Department (YPD) grant funding in the amount up to \$8,750.00 for the purchase of an infrared camera system under Project Mass Gathering.

The infrared camera system would aid specialized units in the search and recovery of bodies during high-risk deployments. The system captures information in darkness and works by detecting infrared radiation from objects emitting heat. The system converts the data it captures and processes it into an image that can be seen on a monitor. Funding must be expended by September 30, 2021.

This infrared camera system assists in furthering the City Council's vision and strategic outcomes as it relates to Safe and Prosperous. The approval of this grant award will provide safety for our officers, as well as others that may be in harms way, as YPD conducts active investigations during high-risk incidents.
