The infrared camera system would aid specialized units in the search and recovery of bodies during high-risk deployments. The system captures information in darkness and works by detecting infrared radiation from objects emitting heat. The system converts the data it captures and processes it into an image that can be seen on a monitor. Funding must be expended by September 30, 2021.

The approval of this grant award will provide safety for our officers, as well as others that may be in harms way, as YPD conducts active investigations during high-risk incidents.
