TITLE:
Job Order Authorization: Avenue A Paving

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize a job order with DPE Construction, Inc. (DPE) in the amount not to exceed \$961,782.43 for pavement replacement on Avenue A from 32nd Street to 36th Street pursuant to the City's Municipal Utility and Roadway Infrastructure Refurbishment and Replacement Job Order Contract. (Engineering) (Jeffrey A. Kramer)

REPORT:

The development of Capital Improvement Program project #0027-Road included evaluation of the pavement and subsurface conditions of Avenue A between 32nd Street and 36th Street, and determined that the pavement within this roadway segment requires replacement. This work will include removing existing failing pavement, repaving the road, and upgrading adjacent driveways and sidewalks to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. Additionally, because this is a key segment of the City's proposed communication network, the City will install conduit and related infrastructure to prevent cutting the road again in the future.

To accommodate the City's Independence Day celebration the project is scheduled to begin after the July 4th holiday, and scheduled to be complete by the end of September.

The City intends to issue a job order for the project to DPE pursuant to the City's Job Order Contract #2017-20000068 – Utility and Roadway Infrastructure (Infrastructure JOC), The City Council awarded the Infrastructure JOC to DPE on May 17, 2017. Pursuant to the Infrastructure JOC, the City issues a separate job order for each project, and any job order exceeding \$100,000 is presented to the City Council for approval. The Infrastructure JOC sets forth the general terms and conditions governing all job orders issued under the contract, with each job order detailing the project's scope of work and any additional terms and conditions specific to the project.

By approving this motion, the City Council authorizes a job order pursuant to the Infrastructure JOC to complete the project.
