

RESOLUTION NO. R2016-014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ARIZONA FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PEDESTRIAN HYBRID BEACON NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF 8TH STREET AND 21ST AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma (City) is empowered by Arizona Revised Statutes § 48-572 and Article III, Section 13 of the Yuma City Charter to enter into this Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Congress has established the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) as a core federal-aid for the specific purpose of significantly reducing traffic fatalities and serious injuries on public roads; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona (State), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the City have identified systematic improvements within the City that are eligible for HSIP funding; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to build a pedestrian hybrid beacon near the intersection of 8th Street and 21st Avenue (Project) to make the intersection safer for pedestrians to cross; and,

WHEREAS, the State, through the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO), will cover the City's matching costs for the administration and construction of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the cost for the construction of the Project is estimated at \$277,349.00, and the State has agreed to provide \$277,349.00 in federal-aid money for the construction of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, to receive the federal-aid money, the City is required to fund any cost overruns during the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the State, through the Arizona Department of Transportation, will advertise, bid, award and administer the design and construction of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the State authorizing the allocation of funds and construction of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yuma as follows:

SECTION 1: The intergovernmental agreement between the State of Arizona and the City of Yuma is approved in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated to this Resolution by this reference.

SECTION 2: The City Administrator is authorized and directed to execute the attached intergovernmental agreement and take all steps necessary to carry out the purpose and intent of this Resolution.
