**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA,
ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING AMENDMENT NO.
ONE TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH
ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DATED OCTOBER
20, 2023, FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF PEDESTRIAN
HYBRID BEACONS AT 32ND STREET AND MICHIGAN AVENUE AND
AVENUE C AT CENTRAL CANAL NORTH OF 22ND LANE**

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma desires to amend the Intergovernmental Agreement (“Agreement”) between the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the City of Yuma (City) dated October 20, 2023; and,

WHEREAS, a public need exists for improvements at the following locations: 32nd Street and Michigan Avenue and South Avenue C at Central Canal North of 22nd Lane referred to as the “Project”; and,

WHEREAS, Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding requires the City to enter into an IGA with the State of Arizona; and,

WHEREAS, Federal Aid funding using HSIP is available for the Project through the Yuma Metropolitan Planning Organization (YMPO); and,

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed that the completion of the Project is essential to the public safety and welfare and desire to cooperate in the completion of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the mutual benefit of ADOT and the City to enter into an amended Intergovernmental Agreement to share the remaining costs required for the construction of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yuma as follows:

SECTION 1: Amendment No. One to the Intergovernmental Agreement between ADOT and the City of Yuma for the design, construction, and financing of the Project, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated as part of this resolution by reference is approved.

SECTION 2: The City Administrator is authorized and directed to execute Amendment No. One to the Intergovernmental Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Yuma.
