

RESOLUTION NO. R2019-050

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA, ADOPTING AN ENFORCMENT RESPONSE PLAN PURSUANT TO YUMA CITY CODE, TITLE 19, CHAPTER 191 INDUSTRIAL WASTES AND OTHER WASTEWATER DISCHARGES

WHEREAS, the Clean Water Act (“Act”) regulates the direct discharge of pollutants into surface waters from locally owned and operated wastewater treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires local governments who own and operate a wastewater treatment facility to obtain an Arizona Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (AZPDES) Permit from the State of Arizona Department of Environmental Quality; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of issuance of AZPDES Permits and federal law require specific provisions such as an Enforcement Response Plan to protect the Publicly Owned Treatment Works and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this Enforcement Response Plan will ensure the continued compliance of the City of Yuma with its AZPDES Permit and federal law; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yuma as follows:

SECTION 1: The Enforcement Response Plan, attached as Exhibit A and incorporated as part of this Resolution by reference, is hereby approved and adopted according to its terms.
