Grant Award: Arizona Companion Animal Spay and Neuter Committee

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute the necessary documents with the Arizona Companion Animal Spay and Neuter Committee (ACASNC) to obtain grant funds to support community programs offering spay and neuter surgeries. (Police/Administration) (John Lekan)

REPORT:

Yuma Police Department's Animal Control Services unit (Animal Control) is tasked with decreasing the number of stray animals in the community. The ACASNC has awarded a total of \$10,000 in grant funding to Animal Control to spay or neuter domesticated and feral animals.

The funds will allow Animal Control to direct \$10,000 to the Yuma County Humane Society to increase spay and neuter efforts in the community. Animal Control will issue vouchers to the Yuma County Humane Society when it renders spay or neuter services. Animal Control will use the grant funds to pay the authorized fees.

All funds must be expended by August 15, 2017, and any unspent funds must be returned with a final follow-up report.

Approval of this Motion Consent item will result in the City Administrator, Yuma Police Department and City staff to execute and submit the necessary paperwork to obtain grant funding from ACASNC.
