Grant Agreement: U.S. Department of Justice

**SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a grant agreement with U.S. Department of Justice for reimbursement of funds up to \$47,883.00 expended for services in support of the Yuma Regional Communications System (YRCS) Data Interoperability and Information Sharing Project utilizing the FY18 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program. (IT/YRCS) (Eddie Carrera)

**REPORT:**

The Yuma Region implemented a Regional Public Safety Data System consisting of a Computer Aided Dispatch, Records Management System and Jail Management System (CAD/RMS/JMS), where all Yuma County local law enforcement and Fire/EMS agencies from the cities of Yuma, Somerton, and San Luis along with the Yuma County Sheriff Office (YCSO), the town of Wellton and the Cocopah and Quechan Indian Tribes form part of, and have use of, the system.

Yuma County law enforcement agencies have been equipped with Mobile Data Computers (MDC) in their vehicles utilizing the Internet to connect to the CAD/RMS/JMS system through the use of mobile Virtual Private Network and two-factor authentication software. This allows law enforcement personnel in the field access to real-time information gathering and sharing, providing increased productivity and enhancing officer safety. Grant funding was solicited in order to continue to maintain interoperable data-sharing communications between public safety agencies in Yuma County while accessing and sharing information from the federal, state and local levels.

Under this grant agreement, the City of Yuma would be reimbursed up to \$47,883.00 for services in support of the YRCS Data Interoperability and Information Sharing Project that must be utilized by September 30, 2021. The grant funds will be managed and disbursed by the YRCS division of the City of Yuma Information Technology Services Department. There is no requirement of matching funds.

By approving this motion, the City Council will authorize the City Administrator to execute this grant agreement for the City to be reimbursed for services utilized in support of the YRCS Data

Interoperability and Information Sharing Project utilizing the FY18 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program.
