Grant Awards: Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety

**SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the City Administrator to execute two agreements with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety for the acceptance of two separate grant awards in the combined total amount of \$45,000 to cover overtime expenses associated with the DUI/impaired driving enforcement programs, and selective traffic enforcement programs. (Police/Patrol) (Susan Smith)

**REPORT:**

The Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) sought proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety for the 2020-2021 federal fiscal year. Specifically targeted areas include DUI/impaired driving enforcement programs and selective traffic enforcement programs.

The City of Yuma, through the Yuma Police Department, has been awarded funds through two separate grant awards (GOHS Contract #'s: 2020-405d-055 and 2020-PTS-076) to cover overtime expenses associated with the DUI/impaired driving enforcement programs, and selective traffic enforcement programs. The City was awarded \$20,000.00 to cover the costs for overtime pay associated with DUI/impaired driving enforcement special details and \$25,000.00 for selective traffic enforcement programs, for a total grant award of \$45,000.00.

All funds for both grants must be spent or returned to the state by September 30, 2020.
