**TITLE:**

Intergovernmental Agreement: Crane School District Speed Beacons

**SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Crane School District 13 for the operation and maintenance of 16 solar-powered flashing speed zone beacons. (Engineering) (Jeffrey A. Kramer)

**REPORT:**

Crane School District (Crane) approached the City earlier this year to express concerns about school zone safety and asked if the City could assist. The areas in question, Avenue C between 8<sup>th</sup> Street and 20<sup>th</sup> Street, 16<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to 45<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and 20<sup>th</sup> Street from Avenue B to 45<sup>th</sup> Avenue, includes seven Crane schools (Salida Del Sol, Rancho Viejo, HL Suverkrup, Reagan, Valley Horizon, Pueblo, and Centennial), one Yuma Union High School District school (Cibola), and the Desert View Academy.

City staff reviewed the conditions in the field, accident history, and other related factors, and determined that there was a need for additional school zone safety measures. After evaluating options and discussing with Crane, who coordinated with the other schools, the City proposed to enter into a partnership where the City will install a series of 16 solar-powered flashing school zone beacons (beacons), supplemental signing, and upgrade three crosswalks to higher-visibility markings.

Crane has agreed to be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the beacons, including coordinating operating times with the non-Crane schools, and ensuring the beacons are maintained in proper working condition. City staff has initiated the installation of the improvements through normal operating procedures. The IGA requires Crane to provide liability insurance and indemnification to the City in the event of any claims arising from the use of the beacons.

Approval of this item will initiate the IGA allowing Crane to be responsible for the ongoing operation and maintenance of the beacons.
