TITLE:

Bid Award: 4th Avenue Paving - 32nd Street to 40th Street

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Award a contract for the construction of the 4th Avenue Paving from 32nd Street to 40th Street in the amount of \$1,616,631.50 to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

REPORT:

The section of 4th Avenue from 32nd Street to 40th Street has been the subject of extensive citizen complaints for a number of years due to excessive potholes, pavement deterioration, and lack of turning lanes. The City's pavement management system indicates that the pavement has deteriorated too far for repair, and geotechnical investigation performed confirmed that the pavement and base structure has failed to the point that full reconstruction is required.

This project will reconstruct the roadway pavement section to meet current City standards, and will address other related needs including updating streetlights, addition of a continuous center two-way left turn lane, installation of a needed sewer manhole, and pedestrian safety enhancements (multi-use pathway improvements and new crosswalks).
