TITLE: Intergovernmental Agreement: Crane Elementary School District No. 13.					

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Crane Elementary School District No. 13 for the installation, operation, and maintenance of speed flashing beacons along 32nd Street in front of Crane Middle School. (Engineering/Traffic) (Jeffrey Kramer)

REPORT:

The current speed limit along 32nd Street near Crane Middle School is 45MPH and the roadway consists of one through lane in each direction with a center turn lane. During the 2016-17 school year, Crane Elementary School District No. 13 (District) asked City staff for assistance in managing the speeds adjacent to Crane Middle School on 32nd Street. The City determined that approximately four to seven pedestrians use the crosswalk both before and after school. The number of pedestrians using the crosswalk does not meet the minimum requirements to create a 15MPH SCHOOL ZONE per traffic safety guidelines set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

As an alternative, the City allowed the District to create a variable 25MPH zone with speed flashing beacons on the north and south sides of 32nd street near Crane Middle School. The District has already installed the beacons, but as a condition of the District's encroachment permit, the District was required to sign an agreement with the City regarding the installation, operation, and maintenance of the beacons.

Under the terms of the intergovernmental agreement (IGA), the District may use certain portions of the right-of-way solely to install, operate, and maintain two beacons near Crane Middle School – one each on the north and south sides of 32nd Street. The District, at its sole cost, is responsible to maintain the beacons in accordance with most current edition of the MUTCD, and may only operate the beacons before and after school. The District is also required to indemnify the City for any claims that arise from the District's negligence in installing, operating, or maintaining the beacons. The IGA has an initial term of five years, which will automatically renew for two additional five-year terms unless either party terminates the IGA. Upon termination, the District is responsible to remove the beacons and restore the right-of-way to its pre-installation condition.

By approving this motion, the City Council authorizes the City Administrator to execute an IGA with the District for the installation, operation, and maintenance of speed flashing beacons along 32nd Street in front of Crane Middle School.
