TITLE:

Intergovernmental Agreement: Yuma County - County 8th Street Improvements

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Yuma County for the reconstruction and widening of a portion of County 8th Street between Avenue C to east of Avenue D to a five-lane roadway with curb, gutter, sidewalk, street lights, stormwater improvements and detention basins.

REPORT:

The proposed IGA with Yuma County provides for roadway improvements to County 8th Street (5 lanes) with Yuma County and the City of Yuma (City) splitting costs. Yuma County will administer the contract including design, bid award, relocation of utilities (except City water and sewer), construction and inspection. The cost of project administration is treated as part of the project cost but is limited to no more than 10% of the estimated \$3,000,000 project cost.

Under the IGA, the City will pay 50% of the project cost, and all costs associated with relocation of the City's water distribution system or sanitary sewer collection system. The water and sewer relocation is not calculated as part of the project cost, or subject to the 50% cost sharing.

The IGA also provides for City annexation (transfer) of a portion of County 8th Street shown in the attached location map. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 9-471(N), this can be accomplished by mutual consent of both the Yuma County Board of Supervisors and the City Council as a separate agenda item. The IGA requires both entities to complete the described annexation within 60 days of the effective date of the IGA.

Upon completion of the project, the City will be responsible for those portions of the project within City boundaries, the stormwater force main, and Yuma County will be responsible for those portions of the project outside the City. Additionally, the IGA will require the City to obtain an encroachment license for the Lawler Lateral irrigation crossing, and a City agreement with the Yuma County Flood Control District for disposal of the project's stormwater into the Avenue C conduit system. Yuma County will transfer ownership of the detention basin parcels to the City upon final City payment of the City's share of the project.
