REPORT:

The City has a need to contract for landscape construction and consulting services on an as-needed basis. The City plans to use the contractors to convert selected, existing retention basins and City rights-of- way to xeriscape landscaping to improve our basin aesthetics, lower water costs, and reduce the overall maintenance cost of retention basins.

Yuma, Arizona

In November 2017, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 34-604, the City issued a request for qualifications (RFQ) for landscape construction and consulting services on an as-needed basis with the intent to award contracts to multiple licensed landscape companies. The resulting contract is often referred to as a job-order contract. Under the A.R.S § 34-604, the City must determine and rank the companies that are most qualified to provide the services before negotiating a contract price.

Three companies submitted proposals in response to the RFQ, and all three are qualified to provide the services. Upon City Council's approval of this motion, the City will begin separate negotiations with each qualified company to finalize a contract price. If the City and each qualified company can

agree to a contract price, the City will execute job-order contracts with all three companies. The total value of all three contracts are not expected to exceed \$140,000 per year.					
By approving this motion, the City Council authorizes the City Administrator to negotiate and execute a job-order contract with the three companies listed above for landscape construction and consulting					
services.
