STRATEGIC OUTCOME:							
This item supports the City Council's vision and strategic outcome area of Safe and Prosperous by improving accessibility to City services and applications for field personnel and ensures compliance with the City's cybersecurity posture and state and federal regulatory requirements.							
REPORT:							
A majority of the City's public safety Mobile Data Computers (MDCs) will reach the end of manufacturer support this fiscal year. Once hardware reaches end of support, staff will be unable to install software updates, which are necessary to maintain compliance with state regulated cybersecurity requirements.							
The purchase would consist of 124 MDCs with docking stations and six desktop docking units, warranty and mounting hardware for the police department from Dell Marketing LP through the Arizona State Contract. The purchase for the fire department is for 20 iPads and 22 docking units, warranty and mounting hardware from CDWG through the National IPA cooperative purchase agreement.							
Staff will surplus replaced equipment in accordance with the policies and procedures.
