TITLE:

Job Order Authorization: 16th Street Paving Avenue B to Avenue C

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a job order with CEMEX Construction Materials South LLC (CEMEX), in an amount not to exceed \$1,599,023.89, for capital improvements to 16th Street from Avenue B to Avenue C via the City's Job Order Contracting program. (Engineering) (Jeffrey A. Kramer)

REPORT:

The City intends to issue a job order to CEMEX (Contractor) pursuant to City Job Order Master Contract #2019-20000036 – Transportation, Pathways and Pavement, awarded December 5, 2018 (JOC Contract).

Pursuant to the JOC Contract, the City issues a separate job order for each project assignment. The JOC Contract sets forth the general terms and conditions governing all job orders issued under the contract, with each job order providing the individual project's scope of work and any additional terms and conditions specific to the project.

The proposed work will occur from the west side of the 16th Street and Avenue B intersection through the intersection of Avenue C. The City has been systematically upgrading its infrastructure, including roadway sections with deteriorating pavement and severe cracking as well as outdated water and wastewater infrastructure in an effort to improve service levels and maintenance costs.

Under the proposed job order the Contractor will remove and replace three inches of existing pavement on 16th Street from west of Avenue B to west of Avenue C, install new communications infrastructure for the full length, replace several waterline valves, replace handicap ramps to meet current ADA requirements, install new video traffic signal detection systems and new thermoplastic pavement markings.

The project requires heightened communication and coordination with several schools, Yuma Fire Department and MCAS Yuma off-base housing to coordinate access at all times.

It is estimated that the Contractor will complete the project within 120 days after the notice to proceed is issued.

The pavement replacement is anticipated to extend the life of the roadway up to an additional 15-20 years.

By approving this motion, the City Council authorizes a job order for the referenced project pursuant to the approved JOC Contract.
