Memorandum of Understanding: Yuma Elementary School District No. 1

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Yuma Elementary School District No. 1 in support of the United States Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services 2013 Hiring Program Grant.

REPORT:

In October 2013, the Yuma Police Department (YPD) received \$1,000,000.00 from the United States Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) 2013 Hiring Program Grant to hire eight full-time, partially-funded, Neighborhood School Resource Officers (NSRO). A NSRO works with his or her assigned schools to address and promote school safety and act as a positive role model. This is the third year of the three-year grant period. The grant required the City of Yuma (City), through YPD, to execute a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between the schools or school districts affected by the deployments of NSROs.

Under the MOU, YPD will assign a NSRO to one or more of the Yuma Elementary School District No. 1 (District) schools and the school's surrounding neighborhoods to ensure students are safe while in class, and when traveling to and from school. The last MOU between the District and the City expired on December 31, 2015 and needs to be renewed. The MOU takes effect retroactively to January 1, 2016 and terminates on December 31, 2018.
