TITLE:

Right-of-Way Easement and Line Extension: Fleet Services Maintenance Shop

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Grant a right-of-way easement and line extension to Arizona Public Service Company (APS) for the construction, installation, reconstruction, replacement, removal, repair, operation and maintenance of a line, or lines of poles or towers, together with appurtenant structures, facilities and fixtures, to facilitate the relocation of their powerlines crossing the City's new Fleet Services Maintenance Shop site to the perimeter of the property. REPORT:

To accommodate construction of the new Fleet Services Maintenance Shop it is necessary for APS to relocate their existing powerlines to the perimeter of the site. The form of easement and line extension is included with this RFCCA along with a location map. The proposed easement will grant APS the right to permanently relocate, reconstruct, repair, operate and maintain their facilities and appurtenances within and adjacent to City right-of-way. This right-of-way easement and line extension were already approved in MC 2017-058 line extension and MC 2017-059 relocation easement on March 15, 2017 for both to be granted. This ordinance is to grant and record the right-of-way easement and line extension.
