

ORDINANCE NO. O2017-023

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 211 OF THE YUMA CITY CODE, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO TRUCK ROUTES AND TRAFFIC, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma has designated within the Streets and Traffic Code a way over certain streets, which trucks coming into and going out of the city must operate; and,

WHEREAS, from time to time it may be desirable to modify the Truck Routes in keeping within the context of a dynamic and growing community; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted an amendment to the City of Yuma General Plan – Transportation Element on February 17, 2016 (R2016-004) to incorporate the Truck Routes identified in the Transportation Master Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on May 22, 2017, in Zoning Case ZONE-17127-2017 in the manner prescribed by law for the purpose of amending the City of Yuma Zoning Code; and,

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such public hearing was given in the time, form, substance and manner as provided by law, including publication of such notice in the Yuma Sun on April 28, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission regarding Zoning Case ZONE-17127-2017 and finds that the zoning code text amendment fulfills the goals and objectives of the Yuma General Plan, and is in basic harmony with the goals and objectives of the City of Yuma Zoning Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Yuma as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Yuma City Code, Title 21, Chapter 211, Section: 21 Intent be amended to delete the strikethrough text and to insert the bold text for Statutory Reference thereof:

*Power of officials to restrict truck usage of streets, see A.R.S. § ~~28-1012(C)~~ **28-1006 (C)***

SECTION 2: That the Yuma City Code, Title 21, Chapter 211, Section: 22 Truck Routes and Traffic be amended to delete the strikethrough text and to insert the bold text in subsections (A) and (B) for established Truck Routes thereof:

211-22 Truck Routes and Traffic.

—~~(A)~~ There is hereby established within the city the following truck routes:

Avenue 9E	Both	Highway 95 to County 14th Street
Giss Parkway	Both	4th Avenue to Castle Dome Avenue

24th St.	Both	From east city limits to "A" Ave. Avenue D to Avenue 3E

~~(B)~~ In addition to those streets in the city set aside as truck routes, the following streets may be used for truck traffic:

Street	Direction	Extent
"A" Ave.	Both	From 32nd St. to 1st St.
Arizona Ave.	Both	Its entire length, except from 24th St. to 32nd St.
"B" Ave.	Both	Its entire length
Orange Ave.	Both	Its entire length
1st Ave.	Both	From 9th St. to Orange Ave.
1st St.	Both	From 4th Ave. to west city limits
3rd St.	Both	From Madison Ave. to 4th Ave.
4th St.	Both	From Madison Ave. to east city limits
32nd St.	Both	Its entire length

SECTION 3: (A) Any person violating the provisions of this chapter is guilty of a class 3 misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than one day, or both fine and imprisonment. (B) In addition to any penalty imposed under division (A) of this section, any person or corporation that violates any provisions of this chapter is subject to a civil sanction pursuant to A.R.S. § 28-626, unless a code section defining a specific penalty to an offense provides otherwise.
