SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the use of a cooperative purchase agreement through Arizona State Contract to purchase one Broom Bear Sweeper at a total cost of \$272,330.00

REPORT:

The City desires to utilize a cooperative purchase agreement for the purchase of a street sweeper. The funds are included in the Equipment Replacement Fund and approved by City Council for Fiscal Year 2018. The new unit will replace a 2007 year model which has exceeded its eight-year life expectancy.
