**TITLE:**  
 Intergovernmental Agreement: City of Phoenix Arizona for Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force

**SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**  
 Authorize execution of an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Phoenix regarding the Arizona Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force and to accept the awarded grant monies in the amount of \$10,000.00. (Police/Investigations) (Susan Smith)

**REPORT:**  
 This is an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) between the City of Phoenix via the Phoenix Police Department (PPD) and the City of Yuma via the Yuma Police Department (YPD) to continue cooperative work assisting the ICAC Task Force. This cooperative effort includes the investigation, prosecution, and to deter the possession, production and distribution of unlawful images depicting the sexual exploitation of minors and the utilization of the internet to seek children as sexual victims. Agencies involved in the ICAC Task Force seek to increase the number of investigations and prosecutions of ICAC crimes by securing evidence of criminal activity that ultimately leads to the successful prosecution of individuals who have committed coercion/enticement or unlawful image offenses. Under the IGA, YPD will work with the PPD and other agencies affiliated with the ICAC Task Force utilizing a multi-jurisdiction/multi-agency approach to enforce laws regarding internet crimes against children.

In addition to this IGA, YPD received a sub-award from the City of Phoenix via a U.S. Department of Justice grant in the amount of \$10,000.00. This sub-award is a reimbursement program. The funds must be used for directly-related costs such as training, investigations, computer forensics, and public awareness in connection with Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC).
