Grant Award: Fire Prevention and Safety Grant - FEMA Award

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:
Authorize the City Administrator to execute the required documents to accept a grant award from the Department of Homeland Security/FEMA. (Fire/Community Risk Reduction) (Steve Irr)

REPORT:
The Department of Homeland Security/FEMA through the Fire Prevention & Safety Grant has awarded the City of Yuma a \$14,619.05 grant for funding of Knox Boxes and fire safety brochures. As a condition of the grant, the City shall contribute a cost match in the amount of \$730.95 (5% of the \$14,619.05 Federal contribution), for a total grant of \$15,350.00.

The Community Risk Reduction Division will be providing the Knox Boxes to the City's citizens that live alone and may need emergency assistance. Knox Boxes provide a safe and secure location to place keys that only the Fire Department can access. The fire safety brochures will be distributed during Fire Department outreach events.

The City must use the funds and comply with all reporting requirements by September 04, 2020.
