Summary Recommendation: Amend the existing functions of the Parks, Arts and Recreation Commission to broaden the functions of the Commission to include the importance of maintenance and protection of City-owned trees and other woody plants, and to further define the Commission's role as it relates to public art advocacy. REPORT: The City Council created a Parks, Arts and Recreation Commission (PARC) in 2011. The Commission serves as an advisory commission to the City Council and the Parks and Recreation Department on matters related to parks and recreation, arts and culture. The Parks and Recreation Department recommends amending the duties of PARC to serve as a broader scope advisory commission. The additional duties will include: (1) oversight, advocacy and certain defined responsibilities of the Community Tree Board to help sustain and protect the community's trees; and, (2) an advisory role in matters specifically related to focusing on the integration of the highest quality of public art in public places.
