| REPORT: The Yuma Police Department Traffic Unit is requesting to purchase Victory Police Motorcycles. Victory motorcycles have built-in officer safety equipment with a five-year warranty and a lower cost of maintenance than comparable motorcycles available from other vendors. The Yuma Police Department (YPD) purchased one Victory Police Motorcycle in December of 2015. The motorcycle has been thoroughly tested and evaluated by the YPD Traffic Unit motor officers and has proved to be a solid platform for motor officers' work. The design of the motorcycle – in conjunction with the standard police equipment it arrives with – provides the greatest degree of safety for our officers.
