"Vice-Chairman Alan Pruitt asked for clarification on how drivers unfamiliar with this area would be aware of the updated Truck Route listing. Jennifer Albers, Principal Planner, said the adopted document would be available to truck routing companies and truck drivers.

"Commissioner Kim Hamersley asked if the Truck Route list has expanded since it was last updated. Albers said yes. Hamersley asked if this proposal would change the street maintenance schedule. Albers explained that each roadway was analyzed by the Public Works Streets Division and evaluated on a regular basis to ensure the roadways were in a standard condition. When roadways start to fail, they become a part of the CIP (Capital Improvement Program) and are scheduled for improvements."
