SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Amend Title 21 Streets and Traffic Code, Chapter 211 (Sections: 21 and 22) to update the listing of Truck Routes within the City of Yuma. (ZONE-17127-2017)

REPORT:**PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATION:**

On May 22, 2017, the Planning and Zoning Commission voted to recommend APPROVAL (4-0, with Pruitt, Abplanalp, Hamersley, and Jones voting for and Hamel, Lund and Dammeyer absent) of the request by the City of Yuma for a Streets and Traffic Code Text Amendment to update the listing of Truck Routes within the City of Yuma.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – EXCERPT FROM PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION MINUTES:**QUESTIONS FOR STAFF**

“**Vice-Chairman Alan Pruitt** asked for clarification on how drivers unfamiliar with this area would be aware of the updated Truck Route listing. **Jennifer Albers, Principal Planner**, said the adopted document would be available to truck routing companies and truck drivers.

“**Commissioner Kim Hamersley** asked if the Truck Route list has expanded since it was last updated. **Albers** said yes. **Hamersley** asked if this proposal would change the street maintenance schedule. **Albers** explained that each roadway was analyzed by the Public Works Streets Division and evaluated on a regular basis to ensure the roadways were in a standard condition. When roadways start to fail, they become a part of the CIP (Capital Improvement Program) and are scheduled for improvements.”
