SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION: Amend Section 37-02 (F) of the Tax Code of the City of Yuma setting a new repeal date for the two-level tax rate. (Finance/Administration) (Lisa Marlin)					
REPORT: The City Council adopted a two-level tax rate on the sale of tangible personal property over a certain threshold on April 7, 1999 via Ordinance No. O99-22. The result of the two-level tax rate is that the standard sales tax applied to the initial amount of the purchase, but on any amount over the initial threshold, the tax rate is zero percent.					
The two-level tax has been renewed several times, most recently by O2015-029 on May 20, 2015. In that action, City Council set the two-level tax threshold at \$35,000.00. This means that the standard City sales tax (1.7%) on the sale of tangible property would only apply to the first \$35,000.00 of the transaction and a tax rate of zero percent would be applied to the value above \$35,000.00. City Council's prior action also ended the two-level tax on June 30, 2018.					
This proposed amendment to the Yuma City Code will keep the two-level tax rate at \$35,000.00 and will adopt a new ordinance with a retroactive effective date of July 1, 2018 and a repeal date of June 30, 2021.
