Grant Award: Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a grant agreement with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety for highway safety projects in accordance with Arizona's 2017 Federal Fiscal Year Highway Safety Plan. (Police/Patrol) (John Lekan)

REPORT:

The Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) sought proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety for the 2017 federal fiscal year. Specifically targeted areas include DUI/impaired driving enforcement programs and selective traffic enforcement programs.

The City of Yuma, through the Yuma Police Department, has been awarded funds (GOHS Contract #: 2017-405d-047) to purchase a police motorcycle and related accessories to assist with the DUI/impaired driving enforcement programs, and selective traffic enforcement programs. The City was awarded \$27,000.00 to purchase one police motorcycle. The City is not required to provide matching funds for this grant award.

All funds for the grant must be spent or returned to the GOHS by September 30, 2017.
