**TITLE:**

Intergovernmental Agreement: Arizona State University Center for Violence Prevention and Community Safety

**SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize City Administrator to enter into an agreement to provide reports of homicides, suicides and "undetermined cause" deaths to Arizona State University Center for Violence Prevention and Community Safety who is participating in the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's Violent Death Reporting System program. (Police/Support Services) (Susan Smith)

**REPORT:**

The partnership of Arizona State University Center for Violence Prevention and Community Safety and Yuma Police Department will assist in comprehensive data collection on violent deaths. The objective is to provide coordinated data collection, analyses and dissemination of findings via the Arizona Violent Death Reporting System (AZ-VDRS) to the Centers for Disease Control's (CDC) National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS).

This data collection will enhance CDC's ability to track trends nationally and influence national prevention efforts. NVDRS is the first system to provide detailed information, including brief narratives, on circumstances precipitating violent deaths and to combine information across multiple data sources in order to link multiple deaths that may relate to one another.

Additionally, AZ-VDRS aims to provide Arizona communities with similar data driven information in order to guide local policies and programs with the hopes of augmenting response and prevention of violent deaths. The information provided by the Yuma Police Department to the Arizona State University Center for Violence Prevention and Community Safety will be compliant with Arizona and Federal law and will contain appropriate redactions on crime victim identification and all other necessary redactions to protect privacy rights.
