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REPORT:

Cooperative contracts are competitively bid and awarded by the State of Arizona to vendors that supply items such as automotive and equipment repair parts, aftermarket, emergency vehicle accessories and other items that are required. The utilization of these contracts will provide lower prices due to volume purchasing, and will save in administrative costs by not having to repetitively bid the same commodities. Utilizing the cooperative agreements will allow the City to add and/or delete vendors as updates or changes occur.

The City requires that purchases be made as needed for many of these items in support of daily operations of Fleet Services and other City divisions. Most of the purchases will be made through local vendors participating in these cooperative purchase agreements.
