TITLE:

Grant Award: Emergency Response Fund Grant

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute any further required documents for State Fiscal Year 2019 Emergency Response Fund Grant. (Fire/Suppression) (Steve Irr)

REPORT:

In late 2018, the Yuma Fire Department (YFD), in collaboration with the Yuma County Office of Emergency Management, submitted a grant application to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) for the Emergency Response Fund Grant (ERF). The ERF provides proceeds for needed hazardous materials response equipment intended to protect responders and the public during incidents where hazardous materials may be present.

The ERF application was successful and the agencies in Yuma County, including YFD, received most of what was requested. ADEQ handled the purchasing of the equipment awarded by the ERF and the items then tendered to Yuma County Office of Emergency Management so it can then provide to each of the agencies in its jurisdiction. Through the ERF award, YFD will receive (or already has received) the following items valued at approximately \$4,013.00:

No. of Items	Item Description
1	Qrae3 4 Gas Meter-O2, LEL, H2S, CO: Checks air quality (Oxygen levels, flammable gases, Hydrogen Cyanide gas and Carbon Monoxide gas).
1	Model 26 Frisker: Handheld meter that checks for radioactive materials.
5	Micro Blaza Emergency Liquid Spill Control: A liquid concentrate mixed with water and sprayed on flammable liquids to reduce vapors and chances of fire.
1	Justrite Drum Bung Wrench: Brass wrench used to prevent sparks when opening drums or barrels having flammable liquids.
1	Portable Decon Pool: Collects contaminated water from washing contaminants from HazMat personnel.
1	Poly Drum Spill Kit: A drum or barrel containing materials to soak up leaking fluids.

1	Hi Vis Dyke Tubing-Roll: Large plastic tubing used to create a portable dam placed around leaks to slow or stop their spread.
10	Neoprene HazMat Gloves: Used to go over HazMat suits for personal protection.

As of the date of this Request for City Council Action, YFD has received almost all of the equipment awarded under the ERF and the equipment is in the field ready for use. Because ADEQ administered the ERF and purchased the equipment through its state vendors and Yuma County Office of Emergency Management distributed the equipment directly to YFD, the City has not been presented any required documentation to date. It is possible that the awarding agency may not require anything further from the City. However, if documentation is necessary, this City Council motion will authorize and direct the City Administrator to execute any required documentation to fulfill the grant.
