SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the City Administrator to execute five Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) subrecipient agreements totaling \$102,000 in accordance with the 2019 Annual Action Plan. (Community Development/Neighborhood Services) (Laurie Lineberry)							
REPORT: The Yuma City Council, on June 5, 2019, approved the City of Yuma 2019 Annual Action Plan, which, in part, set aside CDBG funds from the US Department Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for local nonprofit entities to administer approved activities. The activities provided through the CDBG program further the City's long-standing mission of assisting residents with need. The City has							

negotiated subrecipient agreements allocating CDBG funds totaling \$102,000 to the following local nonprofit entities: Funds Subrecipient Service Provided Awarded Ballet Lessons for Homeless Children Arizona Classical Ballet \$ 7,000 Catholic Community Services Home Delivered Meals \$ 9,000 Crossroads Mission Nutrition Program \$ 30,000 9th Avenue Group Home Rehab Saguaro Foundation \$ 40,000 Western Arizona Council of Fair Housing Outreach, Education \$ 16,000 Governments

Total \$102,000

The attached subrecipient agreements and funding amounts conform to the City of Yuma 2019 Annual Action Plan. Each agreement has a one-year term.

The CDBG funds awarded by these agreements are a portion of the total CDBG allocation received by the City of Yuma for FY 2019-20. The balance of the funding, \$741,078.00 is dedicated to activities administered by the Neighborhood Services Division. Those activities – rehabilitation of owner-

occupied housing, rental inspections, code enforcement, façade improvements, infrastructure improvements – target the Mesa Heights Neighborhood and are part of the long-term strategy for revitalization of that community.

By approving this motion, the City Council authorizes the City Administrator to execute five subrecipient agreements totaling \$102,000.
