The City intends to establish a formal Cyber Security Program that is comprised of several technologies, processes, and business practices working in tandem designed to protect networks, computers, applications and data from attacks, damage or unauthorized access. The Yuma Regional Communication Systems (YRCS) and City voice and data networks are secure and actively employ many of these attributes today. This grant will help to establish the program and further strengthen cyber security capabilities by implementing consolidating of data for alerting and monitoring solutions enabling a more proactive response to threats.

Security for reimbursement of funds expended for materials, services, labor, equipment and travel expenses in support of the Cyber Security Program. (IT/YRCS) (Eddie Carrera) Agreement Number:

The grant agreement shall be effective from October 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. Under this grant agreement, the City of Yuma will be reimbursed up to \$55,000.00 for materials, services, labor, equipment and travel expenses in support of the Cyber Security Program for the City of Yuma and YRCS. The Arizona Department of Homeland Security grant funds cannot be used for normal, daily operation expenditures. The grant will be managed by YRCS on behalf of the City of Yuma.

By approving this motion, the City Council will authorize the City Administrator to execute this grant agreement for City reimbursement of materials, labor, services, equipment and travel expenses utilized to support and enhance the Cyber Security Program. There are no matching funds required from the City for this grant.
