Summary Recommendation: Authorize the Yuma Fire Department to accept grant funding from Walmart's Community Grants in the amount of \$7,500.00 to purchase training materials for community education of bleeding control/traumatic injury training and fire extinguisher training. Six Yuma Walmart stores have collectively awarded the City of Yuma Fire Department a total of \$7,500.00 to purchase training materials to be used to instruct Yuma's citizens in Traumatic Injury Bleeding Control (Stop the Bleed program) and also to go toward the purchase of a system to help train citizens in the proper use of fire extinguishers. There is no required cost match for this direct award.

Walmart's Community Grants are awarded to a variety of organizations to give back to the communities in which they operate. Public Safety organizations like the Yuma Fire Department are able to enhance the service provided to our citizens through the use of Walmart Community grant awards.

Materials purchased through this award will be used to begin instructing citizens on the Stop the Bleed program. Funds from this grant award will also go toward the purchase of a training device used to instruct citizens in the proper use of fire extinguishers. In the last 10 years Yuma Fire Department's Community Risk Reduction division has presented over 400 CPR classes to over 12,000 citizens and will be using these funds to expand the instructional services currently available.

Through grants and seeking out other available resources, Yuma's Fire Department continues to offer fire safety, injury prevention and CPR classes to Yuma's citizens at no charge and available at times and locations convenient to those we serve.
