Summary Recommendation: Authorize the City Administrator to execute two grant agreements with the Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety for roadway safety programs in accordance with Arizona's Federal Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Highway Safety Plan. (Police/Patrol/Traffic) (Susan Smith)					
REPORT: The Arizona Governor's Office of Highway Safety (GOHS) sought proposals from state and local agencies for projects relating to all aspects of highway safety for the 2020-2021 federal fiscal year. Specifically targeted areas include DUI/Impaired Driving Enforcement Programs and Selective Traffic Enforcement Programs. The City of Yuma, through the Yuma Police Department, submitted a proposal and grant application.					
The City of Yuma, through the Yuma Police Department, has been awarded funds through two separate grant awards to cover overtime expenses associated with the DUI/Impaired Driving Enforcement Program (GOHS Contract #'s 2021-405d-057), and Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) (GOHS Contract #'s 2021-PTS-080). The City has been awarded a total of \$40,000 to cover the costs of overtime pay associated with both programs: \$15,000 for DUI/Impaired Driving Enforcement special details, and \$25,000 for Selective Traffic Enforcement special details. The City is not required to provide matching funds for any of the awards.					
All funds for the two grants will begin on October 1, 2020 and must be spent or returned to the state by September 30, 2021.
