TITLE:

Request for Proposal (RFP): Solid Waste Transfer, Disposal & Recycling Services

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Administrator to execute a 10-year contract with the option to renew for two additional five-year periods, one period at a time, depending on the appropriation of funds and satisfactory performance, with the following vendor:

Allied Waste Transportation Inc., dba Republic Services of Yuma Yuma, Arizona

(Public Works/Solid Waste - RFP #2020-20000052) (Joel Olea/Robin R. Wilson)

REPORT:

Staff issued a RFP for solid waste and recycling services in January of 2020. The City received proposals from two vendors and negotiated with the top scoring vendor, Republic Services.

The contract under consideration is a 10-year contract with two renewal options for five years each. The rate of trash disposal and processing recyclables is \$28.00 per ton for the first two years. The proposed rate is \$2.70 lower than our current rate of \$30.70. The disposal and recycling transfer station rates are subject to a 3% increase starting in 2023. Trash will be disposed of at the Copper Mountain landfill in Wellton, Arizona.

The revenue sharing for recyclables would start with Republic Services receiving 80% and the City receiving 20% for the first \$125,000.00 in any fiscal year. Once the revenues reach \$125,000 in any fiscal year, the revenue sharing changes to the City receiving 80% and Republic Services 20%.

Republic Services will process recyclables locally at the transfer station located at Avenue 3½E and 32nd Street for the duration of the contract. Republic Services will hire three additional staff members and construct a 5,000 square foot addition to the facility for the sole purpose of processing recyclables. Republic Services is granted a transitional period to prepare for the new processing site.

During the transitional period, Republic Services would:

- 1) Be allowed to landfill the recyclables that the City drops off at the Republic Services transfer station for eight months or less, and not to surpass July 1, 2021.
- 2) Establish five drop-off recycling sites per the City's designation for eight months or less, and not to surpass July 1, 2021.

Approval of this motion authorizes the City Administrator to execute the necessary documents for a recycling program through Republic Services.
