Approve an intergovernmental agreement with Marine Corps Air Station-Yuma (MCAS-Yuma) for the use of the City of Yuma Public Safety Training Facility. (Police/Support Services) (Thomas Garrity)

STRATEGIC OUTCOME:

This intergovernmental agreement is in accordance with the City Council's Safe and Prosperous and Connected and Engaged Strategic Outcomes. The approved agreement will allow MCAS-Yuma to use the City of Yuma Public Safety Training Facility for training of their personnel.

REPORT:
