**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA,
AUTHORIZING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER
PROTECTION, U.S. BORDER PATROL, YUMA SECTOR AND THE CITY OF
YUMA**

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma (City) is authorized to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements pursuant to Arizona revised Statutes (A.R.S) § 11-952, *et. seq.*, and Article III, Section 13 of the City Charter; and,

WHEREAS, U.S. Customs and Border Protection, U.S. Border Patrol, Yuma Sector (User Agency) is authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the Homeland Security Act of 2002, as amended; and,

WHEREAS the User Agency is a federal law enforcement agency operating within Yuma County; and,

WHEREAS the City of Yuma Fire Department (YFD) and User Agency often collaborate in areas of medical care, and public safety; and,

WHEREAS the City and User Agency value their cooperative working relationship; and,

WHEREAS User Agency desires to ride-along with Yuma Fire Department personnel for Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training and experience; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to ensure User Agency has access to education and experience that enable EMT certification to personnel.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yuma as follows:

SECTION 1: The attached and incorporated Intergovernmental Agreement specifying the terms and conditions of EMT training for U.S. Border Patrol personnel through the City of Yuma Fire Department is approved.

SECTION 2: The City Administrator is authorized and directed to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City of Yuma.
