

RESOLUTION NO. R2024-061

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA ARMY NATIONAL GUARD FOR THE UPGRADE OF THE EXISTING HVAC SYSTEM AND ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS AT THE YUMA READINESS CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma desires to enter into this Memorandum of Agreement (Agreement) between the Arizona Army National Guard (AZARNG) and the City of Yuma (Yuma), hereafter referred to individually as a “Party” and collectively as the “Parties”; and,

WHEREAS, a public need exists for improvements to the Yuma Readiness Center hereafter referred to as the “Project”; and,

WHEREAS, the Project lies within the jurisdictions of both the City of Yuma and the AZARNG; and,

WHEREAS, Federal funding using the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) is available for the Project through the City of Yuma Grants Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties have agreed that the completion of the Project is essential to the public safety and welfare and desire to cooperate in the completion of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, it is to the mutual benefit of AZARNG and the City of Yuma to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement to share the remaining costs required for the construction of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yuma, Arizona, as follows:

SECTION 1: The Memorandum of Agreement between AZARNG and the City of Yuma for the construction and financing of the Project for the benefit of the citizens and residents of Yuma, attached as Exhibit A is approved.

SECTION 2: The City Administrator is authorized and directed to execute the Memorandum of Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Yuma and the City Clerk is directed to attest the same.

SECTION 3: The various City officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this resolution.
