## **RESOLUTION NO. R2025-008**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUMA, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF YUMA TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE ARIZONA BOARD OF REGENTS, ON BEHALF OF ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY AND ITS CENTER FOR VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND COMMUNITY SAFETY

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma is authorized by A.R.S. § 11-952 to enter into agreements for the joint exercise of any power common to the Parties as to governmental functions necessary for the public health, safety and welfare, and the proprietary functions of such public agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma is authorized to execute and administer contracts pursuant to Article III, Section 13, of the Yuma City Charter; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma Police Department responds to calls for service involving violent crime and death; and,

WHEREAS, Arizona State University operates the Center for Violence Prevention and Community Safety (CVPCS); and,

WHEREAS, CVPCS analyzes patterns and causes of violence, and uses the data to develop strategies and programs aimed at reducing violence and increasing community safety; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Yuma desires to provide relevant data and information to CVPCS in furtherance of their goals,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Yuma as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The City Council finds entering into an intergovernmental agreement with the Arizona Board of Regents on behalf of Arizona State University's Center for Violence Prevention and Community Safety, will assist in analysis and initiatives to decrease violence in Arizona communities, and is therefore in the public interest.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The document titled *Intergovernmental Data Sharing Agreement*, included in the City Council Packet, is on file with the City Clerk and available electronically to the public or upon request to the City Clerk, describes the terms of the agreement between the City of Yuma and the Arizona Board of Regents on behalf of Arizona State
